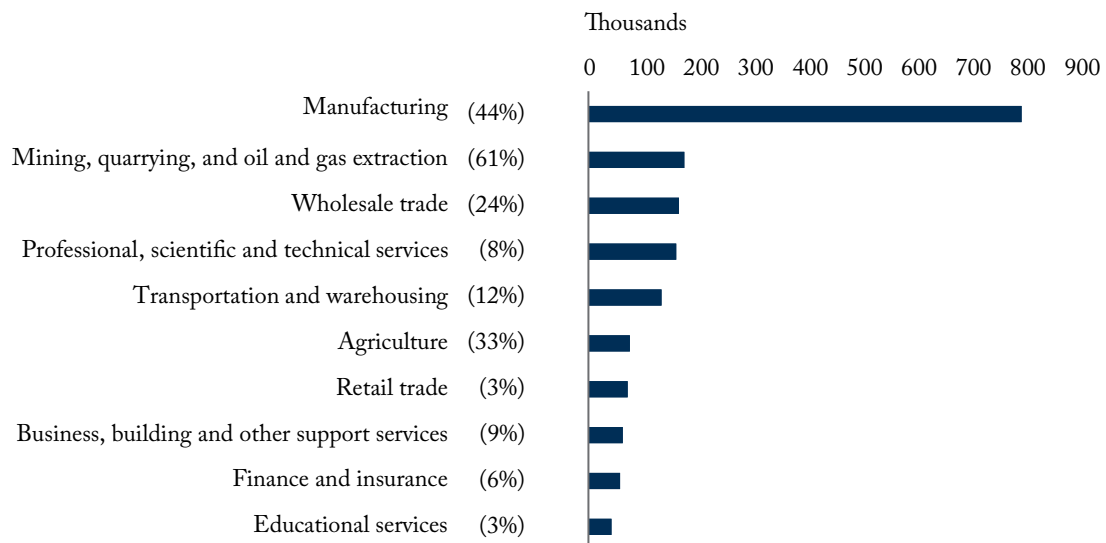

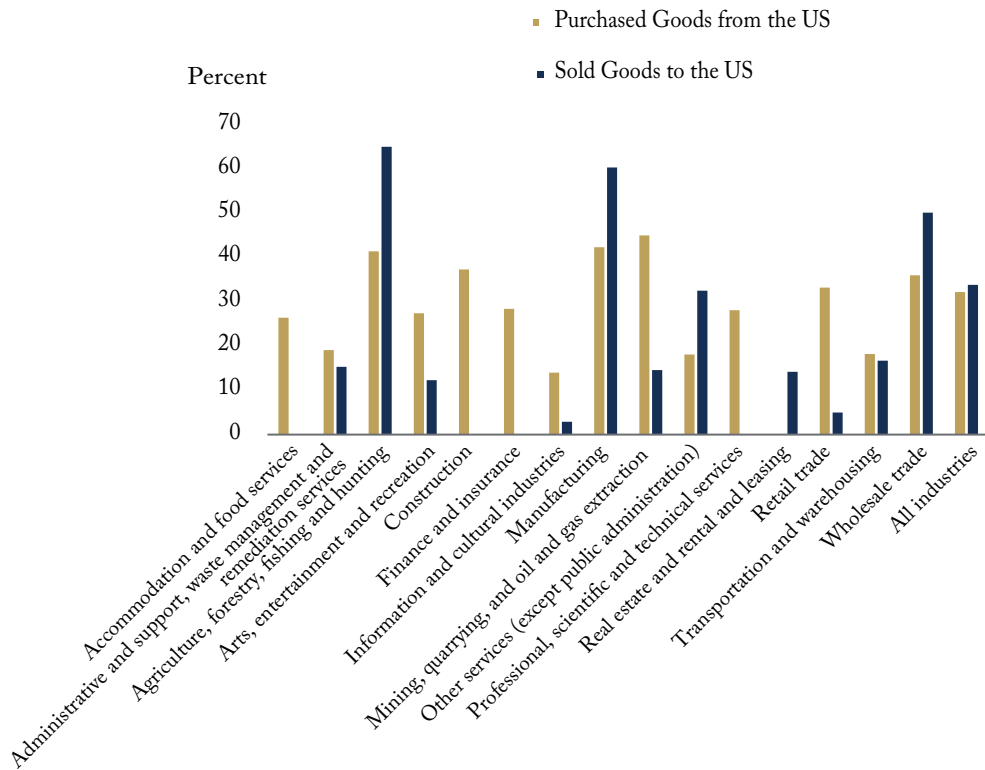
Figure A1: Top 10 Canadian Sectors with Jobs Relying on Exports to the US in 2024



Note: The numbers in brackets represent the share of jobs supported by US demand as a proportion of total jobs in that sector.

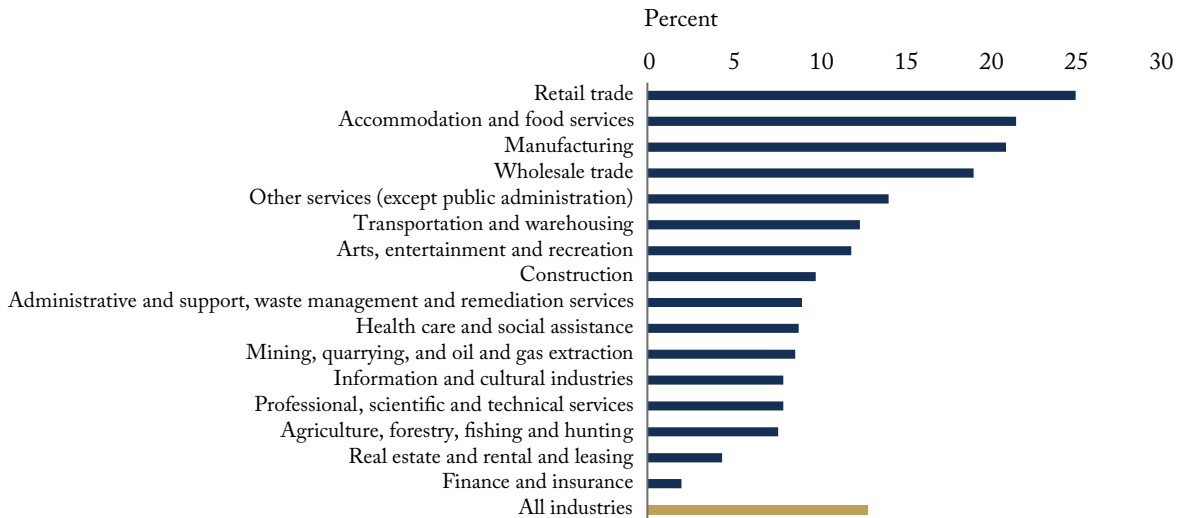

Figure A2: CUSMA-Compliant Trade with the United States, Q4 2025



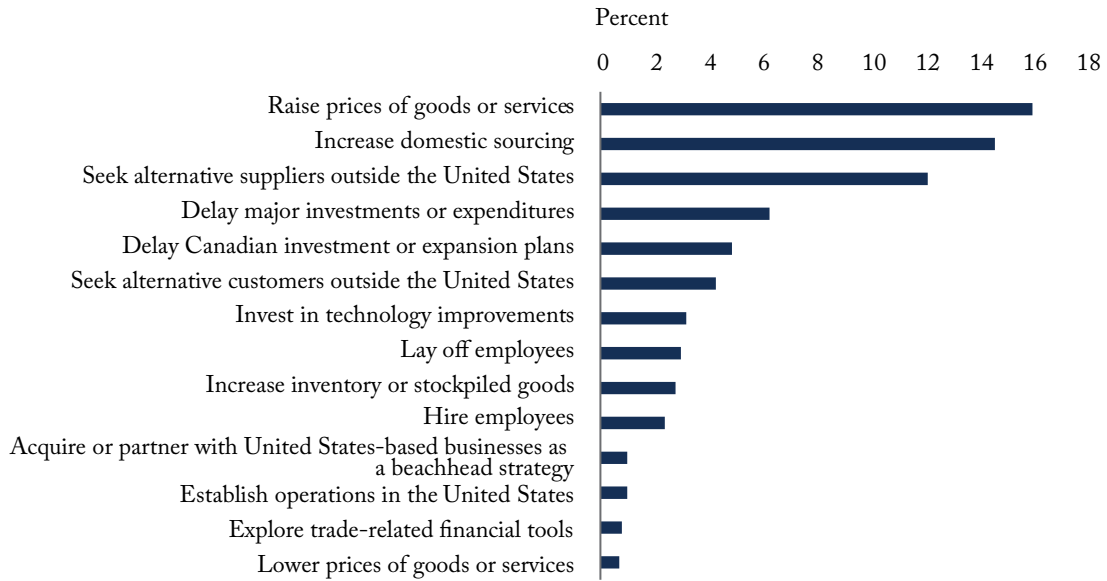

Figure A3: Business Changed Suppliers as a Result of US-Canada Trade War, Q4 2025



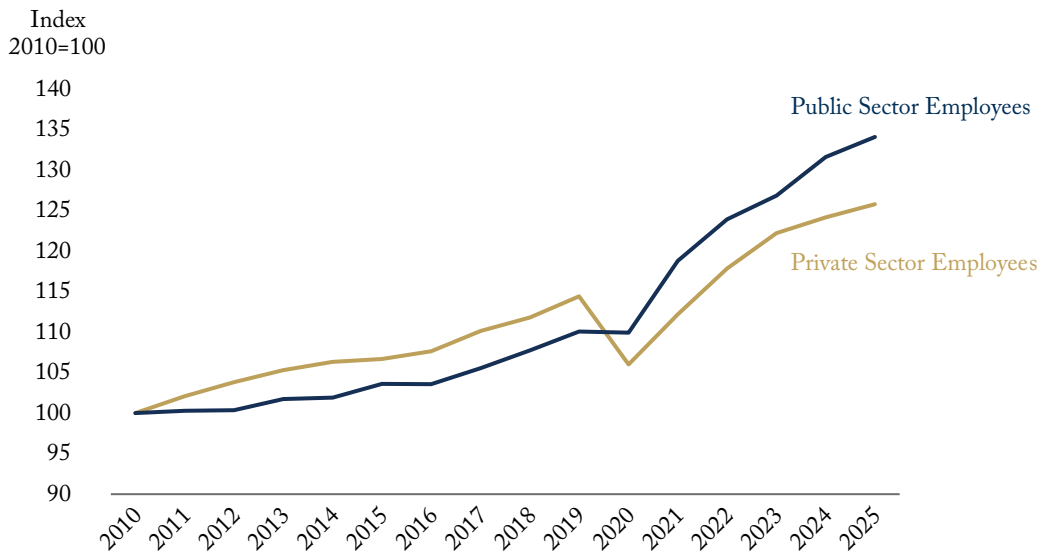

Figure A4: Planned Actions over the Next 12 Months as a Result of Any Tariffs Applied by the United States on Canadian Imports, Q4 2025



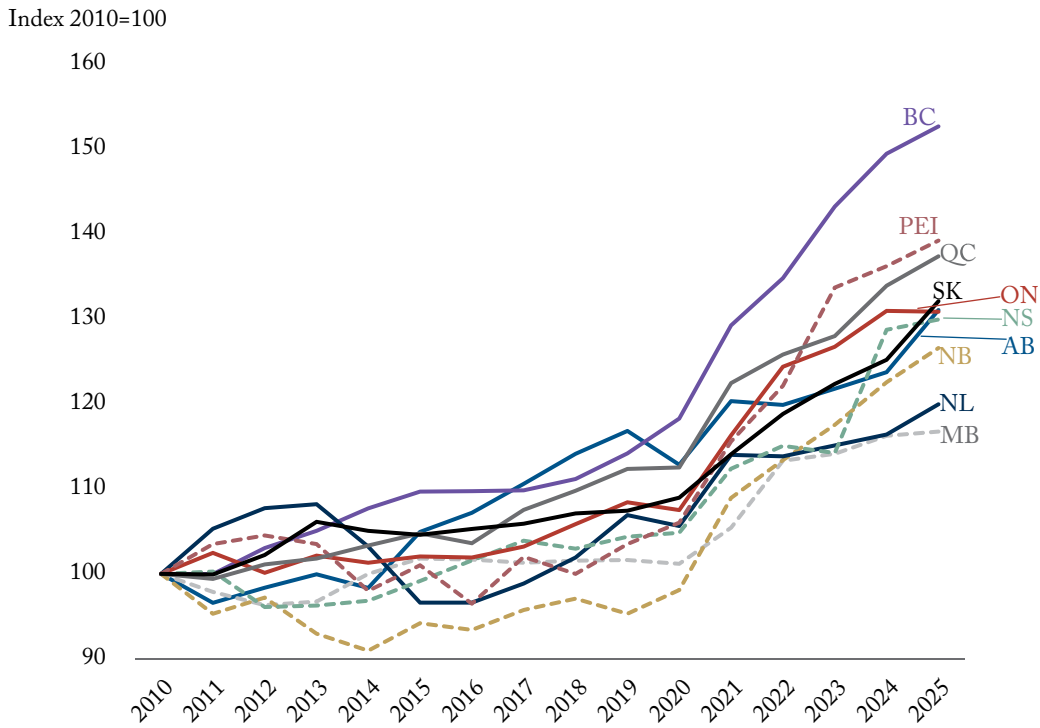

Figure A5: Public Sector Employment Balloons Compared to Private Sector



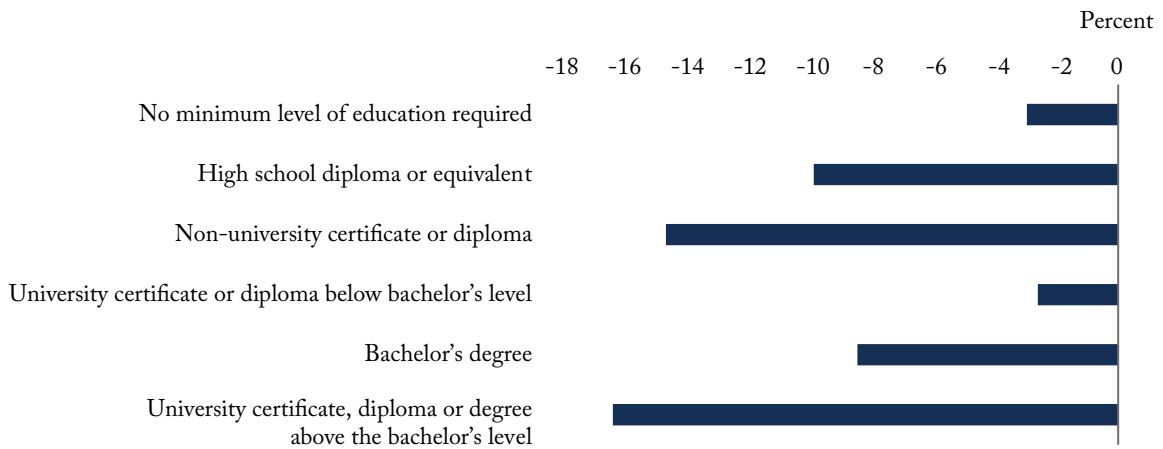
